



RENOLIT signs declaration for more circular economy in the plastics industry

Last Friday, **RENOLIT** signed the so-called Circular Plastics Alliance Declaration, a declaration to encourage the use of more recycled plastics in Europe through voluntary measures.

At the official event held by the EU Commission in Brussels, a total of nearly signed the declaration, thereby expressing their commitment to the thus expressing their commitment to the circular economy in the plastics industry.

The associations and companies have set themselves the ambitious target of that by 2025, at least 10 million tons of recycled plastics should be used in products and packaging by 2025. They intend to work together along the plastics value chains to achieve this goal. achieved. At the same time, they aim to ensure that the functionalities of of plastic products and packaging, such as consumer protection, safety and hygiene are not compromised.
